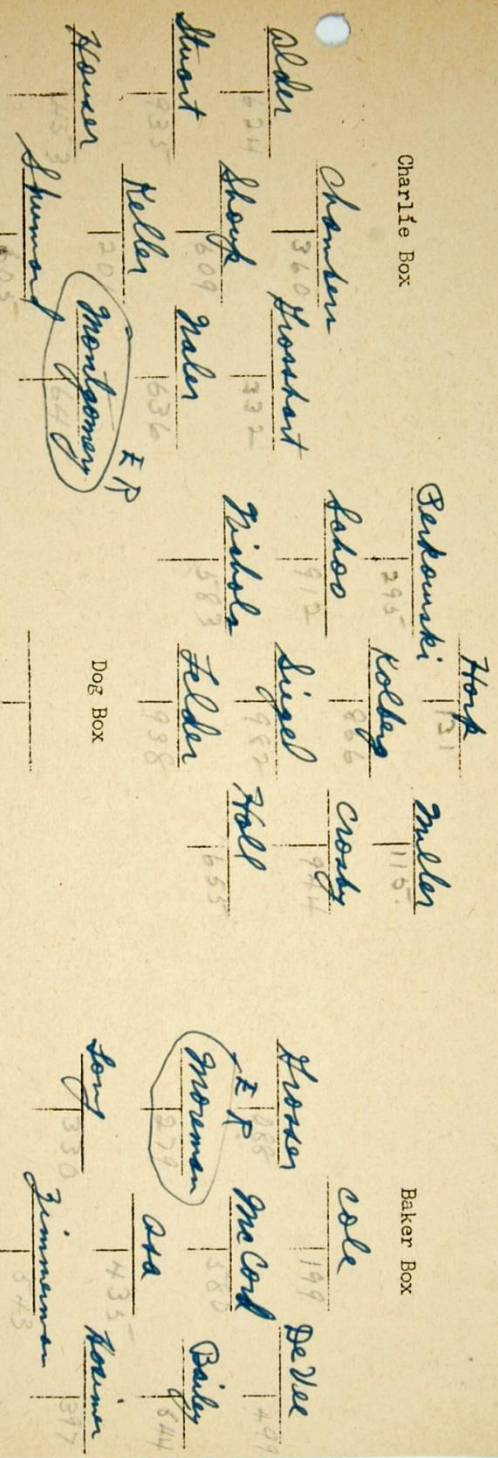
FORMATION DIAGRAM 455TH
