WEATHER ANNEX.

SYNOPTIC SITUATION 0700Z.

Large high just west of Scotland decree sine slightly in intensity. Low forming over Balkans. Mediterranean slowly returning to normal summer conditions with shallow high over central Mediterranean.

FORECAST:

BASE: Sky: Clear.

Air-Ground Visibility: Unrestricted.

Upper Winds: 5000' 300 degrees 05 knots.
10000' 280 degrees 10 knots.
15000' 270 degrees 10 knots.

ROUTE: Sky: Adriatic clear. Swelling cumulus over Apennines

Air-Ground Visibility: 15 miles.

Upper Winds: 10000' 280 degrees 10 knots.
15000' 270 degrees 10 knots.
20000' 270 degrees 10 knots.

TARGET: Sky: 2/10 to 3/10 low cloud at 6000'. Few scattered middle clouds. 3/10 to 5/10 cirrus above 25,000'.

Air-Ground Visibility: 10 to 15 miles.

Surface Wind: West to Northwest and quite light.

Upper Winds: 20000' 270 degrees 10 knots.
25000' 270 degrees 15 knots.

RETURN: 5/10 to 3/10 swelling cumulus at 5000' over base.

ALTERNATE FIELDS: All areas should remain open.
